Dear Mr. Carpenter:

Enclosed is a copy of Amendment #2 to the FY 2014-2018 TIP. This is an administrative amendment that will adjust the programmed amounts for a City of Tucson Transportation Alternative project (TAP). The PAG apportionment for 2013 was greater than originally estimated, and this amendment will allow the City of Tucson to obligate the full TAP amount. This project was selected by the TIP committee to receive any 2013 TAP funds in excess to those which the committee had estimated the region would receive.

Although these funds are listed in the PAG 2014-2018 TIP, the PAG TIP follows the state fiscal year rather than the federal fiscal year. Therefore, the amended funds are from Federal fiscal year 2013 TAP appropriations, even though they are listed in 2014 in this amendment.

I have reviewed the amendment and I concur that it meets with established policies for an administrative amendment on behalf of the Pima Association of Governments.
