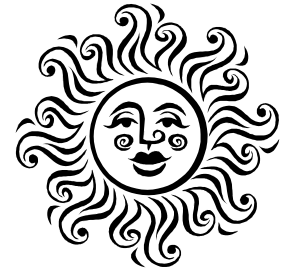

TAX INCENTIVES

Federal: Effective January 1, 2009, there is a 30% federal solar tax credit on approved solar electric and solar hot water systems (pools DO NOT qualify for this). The 30% credit is taken **AFTER** the Arizona tax credit. This tax credit is for each type of solar system (one solar electric and one solar hot water) with no maximum on photovoltaics or solar water heaters.

State: There is a 25% state solar tax credit on an approved solar device or system up to a maximum of \$1,000. You can get this tax credit for only one of the qualifying systems. Qualifying items include solar pool heaters, solar water heaters, solar electric systems (photovoltaic cells), solar water pumps, and solar daylighting systems.

SOLAR FROM FREE TO MOST EXPENSIVE

- Solar orientation (long part of building faces south and north, large windows on south, no windows on west) - \$0.00
- Clothesline - \$5.50
- Solar oven - \$250.00
- Skylight - \$350.00
- Solar water heater - \$5,000 (\$1,500 out of pocket)
- Solar pool heater - \$4,000 (\$3,000 out of pocket)
- Solar electricity - \$13,000 and up (\$5,250 out of pocket and up)
